These funds are NOT available for capital or operating expenses of public transit systems. CDOT anticipates the availability of approximately \$305,619 in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2012; however, please be advised that to date Congress has not yet passed a 2012 appropriation of the federal authorization contained within the SAFETEA-LU legislation.
